## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WARRENSBURG ADOPTING THE JOHNSON COUNTY REGIONAL ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN WHICH WAS UPDATED IN 2018

WHEREAS the City of Warrensburg recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS the City of Warrensburg has participated in the preparation of a multi-hazard mitigation plan hereby known as the Johnson County Hazard Mitigation Plan (Updated 2018), hereafter referred to as the Johnson County HMP, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the Johnson County HMP identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City of Warrensburg from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS the City of Warrensburg recognizes that land use policies have a major impact on whether people and property are exposed to natural hazards, the City of Warrensburg will endeavor to integrate the Johnson County HMP into the comprehensive planning process; and

WHEREAS adoption by the City of Warrensburg demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Johnson County HMP.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City of Warrensburg, in the State of Missouri, THAT:

Section 1. In accordance with local rule for adopting resolutions, the City of Warrensburg adopts the final FEMA-approved plan.

SUBJECT: A Resolution to adopt the Johnson County Hazard Mitigation Plan

#### **BACKGROUND:**

This document is updated every five years and submitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). All entities in Johnson County provide input to the contractor which in turn submits it to FEMA. The contractor is Pioneer Trails Regional Planning Commission. Normally this document is completed earlier but due to changes in their office, it has come to a short deadline. The document needs to be filed by April 1, 2018.

#### **STRATEGIC PLAN:**
