What items will the HHW facility accept?

We will accept almost all chemical items from a residential house, such as: aerosols, batteries, used oil, gasoline, antifreeze, pesticides, herbicides, garden chemicals, household cleaners and fluorescent bulbs.

What items *are not* accepted at the HHW facility?

Explosives, Ammunition, Latex Paint, Asbestos, Smoke Alarms, Radioactive Waste, Unlabeled Items, Medical Waste (Human or Animal)

Who can bring items to the HHW facility?

Any resident of Johnson County

Can business or non-profit use the Household Hazardous Waste Facility?

No, business and non-profit waste is not eligible to be collected at the HHW collection site.
