HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
March 24, 2021

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Karen Hicklin at 4:00 p.m. at the Municipal Center, 200 S. Holden St., Warrensburg, MO.

2. Roll Call

Roll was called and members present included Karen Hicklin, Frances Ellis, Jill Purvis, Don Nimmer, Andrea Glinn. Kristin Dyer, City Planner, was also present.

3. Minutes of Previous Meetings

3.I February 24, 2021

Members reviewed the minutes from the February 24, 2021 Historic Preservation Commission meeting. Nimmer moved to approve the minutes. Glinn seconded. Approved 5-0.

4. Other Business and Appearances

4.I Grover and Broad Streets Survey

Dyer stated that draft report and survey forms were submitted to the State Historic Preservation Office for review on February 28, 2021, and staff should receive comments around the third week of April. Staff and the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) discussed when to host the second public meeting, and Dyer recommended in May as part of National Historic Preservation Month. The HPC discussed potential dates and agreed to May 20, 2021.

4.II Review and Discussion of National Historic Preservation Month

Dyer summarized the list of events that the HPC hosted for National Historic Preservation Month in 2020 including how the events were modified due to COVID restrictions. Purvis stated the annual historic downtown walking tour with Main Street has been moved to October, and Main Street is hosting the architectural scavenger hunt again. Staff and HPC discussed the events and any modifications or additions. The HPC discussed using funds from public outreach supplies and preservation month supplies to fund t-shirts and prizes. The HPC requested to have the National Preservation Month proclamation read at the second City Council meeting in April.

Nimmer moved to adjourn the meeting. Ellis seconded. Approved 5-0, and the meeting adjourned at 4:29 p.m.
