

CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 27, 2021

A meeting of the Warrensburg City Council was held on September 27, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., at 200 S. Holden and via Zoom with Mayor Scott Holmberg presiding. Roll was called as follows, Present were: Brooks, Bentley, Holmberg. Absent: Kushner, Lund.

The minutes of the City Council meeting of September 13, 2021, were considered for approval. Bentley moved to approve the minutes of the September 13, 2021, City Council meeting. Yes: Brooks, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Kushner, Lund.

The adoption of the agenda was considered. Bentley moved to approve the agenda. Yes: Brooks, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Kushner, Lund.

The first item of business was a presentation by HDR Engineering, Inc. regarding Sewer Rate Charges. HDR Engineering, Inc. representative stated during FY2021, consumption was close to projected amount. He stated revenue amount has been greater than originally projected. HDR proposes a 5% increase to volume charge on >2CCF. HDR suggested to delay the blower project. Mayor Holmberg asked how long that project could be delayed. City Manager Danielle Dulin stated staff will be presenting a recommendation to City Council in the near future to use the American Rescue Plan Act Funds to pay for the blower project. HDR also suggested having another 5-year comprehensive rate study.

The next item of business was a First Reading of an Ordinance Authorizing the City Manager and City Clerk to Execute Contracts with Civic Organizations for Fiscal Year 2022 Annual Services. There were no further questions or comments.

Dulin presented a Resolution Approving The Installation Of A Public Art Mural By Main Street, Inc. On The Retaining Wall On The North Side Of The City Hall Building Along Marshall Street. She stated the mural is of the Warrensburg Sun in different colors. Nolan Brooks thought a better design could have been chosen. Bentley moved to approve the resolution. Roll was called as follows: Yes: Bentley, Holmberg. No: Brooks. Absent: Kushner, Lund. Given Resolution number 2200.

During Miscellaneous Matters, Nolan Brooks brought up the trash disposal situation and asked that this matter be put on the next agenda or a future public comment session. Dulin recommended time to allow staff to do some research on other options and then have a work session the second meeting of October.


Mayor Holmberg thanked City staff for all they do and apologized that sometimes their hard work is questioned by citizens on platforms such as Facebook.


As there was no further matters to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
