

## CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF OCTOBER 11, 2021

A meeting of the Warrensburg City Council was held on October 11, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., at 200 S. Holden and via Zoom with Mayor Scott Holmberg presiding. Roll was called as follows, Present were: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. Absent: Brooks.

The minutes of the City Council meeting of September 27, 2021, were considered for approval. Bentley moved to approve the minutes of the September 27, 2021, City Council meeting. Yes: Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Abstain: Kushner, Lund. Absent: Brooks. Failed to pass. Moved to next City Council meeting on October 25, 2021.

The adoption of the agenda was considered. City Manager Danielle Dulin stated she would like to make an amendment to the agenda. Item 8.II, a Resolution Approving the Preliminary Plat of Copper Ridge would be moved to the City Council meeting on October 25, 2021. Lund moved to adopt as amended. Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks.

The first item of business was a First Reading of an Ordinance Accepting the Street and Stormwater Improvements for The Pines at Hale Lake Subdivision for Maintenance by the City of Warrensburg, Missouri. Dulin stated the plans have been approved by staff. There were no further questions or comments.

Bill No. 10-1-2021 being for an Ordinance Authorizing the City Manager and City Clerk to Execute Contracts with Civic Organizations for Fiscal Year 2022 Annual Services was read for second time by title. Bentley moved to approve said ordinance. Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks. Said bill was declared duly adopted and given Ordinance No. 5683.

Bill No. 10-2-2021 being for An Ordinance Suspending the Provisions of Section 3-14 for Certain Special Events October 23, 2021, pursuant to Section 3-14(b) of the Code of Ordinances was read for first and second time by title. Police Chief Rich Lockhart presented this item to allow a tailgating and open container event for UCM Homecoming. Lund moved said bill be passed to second reading by title. Roll was called for the adoption or rejection of said bill as follows: Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks. Carried unanimously and given Ordinance No. 5684.

Finance Director Marcella McCoy presented a Resolution of the City council Authorizing Destruction of Records Held for the Required Period Based on the Missouri Adopted Records Retention Schedule. Lund moved to approve said resolution. Roll was called as follows: Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks. Carried unanimously and given Resolution No. 2201.

Under Appearances to the Council Not Listed on the Agenda, Rachel Gifford, 550 NW 721<sup>st</sup> Road, Centerview, MO 64019, stated she had heard the homeless population was being bussed here from the Kansas City area and wanted to know if it was accurate. Dulin stated the city is aware that because Warrensburg has many services for the homeless, there has been some increase, although not in busloads. Gifford stated she would be interested in assisting if there is such a committee. Dulin will touch base with her after the meeting and she can put Gifford in touch with Journey Home.

Mayor Holmberg thanked Public Works for the hours put in for Burg Fest. Police Department and Fire Department were handing out cookies and lemonade at Lowe's last weekend engaging the public.

Director of Finance Marcella McCoy stated the City ended Fiscal Year 2021 well.


Dulin stated she would like to start the next meeting at 6:00 p.m. on October 25, 2021 as there are some work session items she would like to discuss.
