

CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF OCTOBER 25, 2021

A meeting of the Warrensburg City Council was held on October 25, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., at 200 S. Holden and via Zoom, with Mayor Scott Holmberg presiding. Roll was called as follows, Present were: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. Absent: Brooks.

The minutes of the September 27, 2021, City Council meeting were considered for approval. Holmberg moved to approve the minutes of the September 27, 2021, City Council meeting. Yes: Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Abstain: Kushner, Lund. Absent: Brooks. The minutes of failed to pass.

The minutes of the October 11, 2021 City Council meeting were considered. Lund moved to approve the minutes of the October 11, 2021, City Council meeting. Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks.

The adoption of the agenda was considered. Bentley moved to adopt the agenda. Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks.

Police Chief Rich Lockhart made a presentation on Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design. He explained proper design and effective use of the built environment can deter crime naturally. Lockhart explained four strategies to prevent crime include Natural Surveillance, Territorial Reinforcement, Natural Access Control, and Maintenance. He then presented images from The City of Tampa Public Art Project and explained how art can help prevent crime. Holmberg asked how developers would be made aware of some of these strategies. Lockhart stated in Tampa it is a part of the design review processing by ordinance. Holmberg thanked Lockhart for making this presentation.

Bill No. 10-3-21 being for an Ordinance Accepting The Street and Stormwater Improvements For The Pines At Hale Lake Subdivision For Maintenance By The City Of Warrensburg, Missouri. City Manager Danielle Dulin said there was a first reading of this ordinance two weeks ago. Kushner moved to approve with second reading by title. Roll was called for the adoption or rejection of said bill as follows: Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks. Said bill was declared duly adopted and given Ordinance No. 5685.

Bill No. 10-4-21 being for an Ordinance Accepting The Sanitary Sewer Main Extension Associated With Stonewall Heights, LLC, For Maintenance By The City Of Warrensburg, Missouri. City Manager Danielle Dulin said there are two houses which required this sewer main extension. Dulin stated this extension did pass inspection. She stated the developer has respectfully requested this ordinance be passed with a first and second reading as both houses are ready to be listed on the market. Lund moved to pass the ordinance by second reading by title. Said bill was read a second time by title. Roll was called for the adoption or rejection of said bill as follows: Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks. Said bill was declared duly adopted and given Ordinance No. 5686.

Mayor Holmberg read a Resolution of the City of Warrensburg Amending Personnel Policies regarding Performance Evaluation and Pay Adjustment, Holidays, Domestic Violence or Sexual

Violence Leave and Disciplinary Action by title. Human Resources Greg McCullough said there are some revisions necessary to be made to the personnel policy. He reviewed the changes to be made. Holmberg stated he is proud that the City of Warrensburg is recognizing Juneteenth. Lund moved to approve the Resolution. Roll was called as follows: Yes: Kushner, Lund, Bentley, Holmberg. No: none. Absent: Brooks. Carried unanimously and given Resolution No. 2202.

Director of Finance Marcella McCoy stated the end of the year still looks great.

City Manager Danielle Dulin reported the UCM Homecoming parade had 50 mules and the street sweeper was repaired just in time and held up great.
